Advising Guidelines
June 2021**

Important note: This chart is intended to help students in the Cooperative M.Div. program make informed choices about courses they may take at Hartford Seminary that will satisfy core area degree requirements at Drew Theological School. Students should be aware, however, that whether or not a Hartford Seminary course will meet a specific area requirement is a determination that is finally in the hands of the Drew faculty, and that decision is made after the student has applied and been admitted to Drew. This chart is a reliable guide of equivalency, but not guarantees. Because course offerings and degree/curricular requirements at all institutions change over time, students should ask their advisors each academic year for the most recent version of this document.

Transforming Theologies (3 credits)	TH 505, 513, or 605
Identity, Spirituality, and Vocation (3 credits)	Must be taken at Drew
Bible and Its Interpreters (3 credits)	SC 514, 522, or 531
Global Faiths and the Earth (3 credits)	Must be taken at Drew
Christian Communities in Contexts (3 credits)	HI 523 or HI 532
Gospel Living and Social Transformation (3 credits)	RS 525
Mentored Portfolio C-F (2 credits)	Must be taken at Drew
Vocational Internship and Leadership Seminar (5 credits)	Must be taken at Drew
Immersive Intercultural Experience (3 credits)	Must be taken at Drew
Pathway and Elective courses	All courses eligible

Notes: Up to 39 credits are eligible to transfer to Drew University Theological School. Credits that are not applied to required courses can be applied to electives.
